

Different types of PTT switches

There are many different types of PTT switches on the market, so the selection is NOT so simple

Depends on whether you want Latching or non-latching

Push button or slide etc..

You also have to be careful about the size of cable that the PTT switch can fit.

Most importantly – you have to make sure the headset cable you use has a separate screened mic pair.

This heavy-duty switch is from Astrocom, that has multiple choices of different types of switches, bushings and even volume controls.

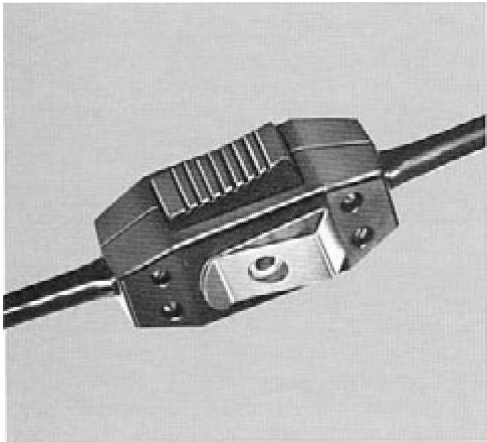
