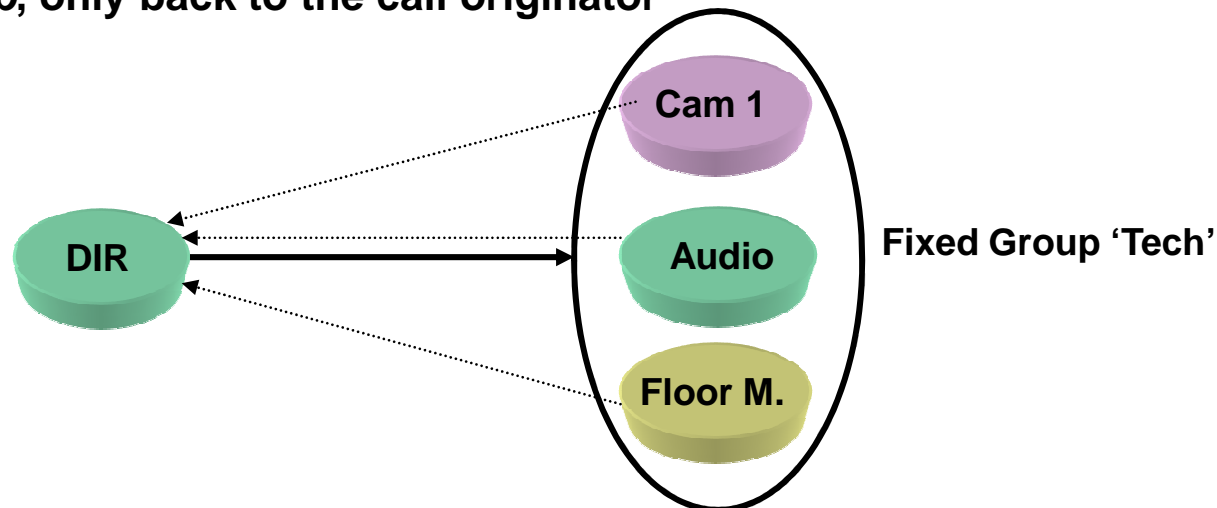


- A Fixed Group is a collection of ports (stations and/or interfaces) and is designated by its group label.
- A group label allows an operator to talk or listen to multiple ports at the same time.
- Eclipse 5.2 maximum limit for fixed groups is 100

Note : *A fixed group facility does not provide communication within the group, only back to the call originator*

Create a new fixed group by pressing the “NEW” button and give it a specific name.

Attach any permanent members to the fixed group by moving them from the available section to the attached section . Fixed Group members can be panels, interfaces, directs, concert client panels and CellCom beltpacks.

Customize the fixed group functionality (tallies, key latch disable, page override) by selecting options in the “Properties “ screen on the right hand window .

Repeat the previous steps for creating additional fixed groups

Note: The available and attached work screens have tabs that allow the user to look for specific label types (all, interfaces and panels)
